Once again, we have made a provisional booking to take the children from Yr1 - Yr6 (school year 2026-2027) to the Panto in December. It might seem very early in the year to think about next Christmas but we wanted to give parents plenty of notice.

Contributions can be made in instalments via Parent Pay or the school office. In order to ensure the trip goes ahead full contributions must be received by the due date in order for us to confirm the booking. **The voluntary contribution required for the Panto this year is £21.00 (including coach and refreshments) and must be paid by 20th July 2026.**

To make this work there are three requirements:

- **Your permission will automatically be given once you make payment via ParentPay. Please note:** if you are making your payment in cash it should be paid direct to the school office or deposited in the drop box located in the entrance. We cannot be held responsible for any missing cash payments that are sent into school via your child's book bag.
- **Contributions must be received by the required date of 20th July 2026.**
- **Please inform school asap if your child is unable to go to the panto, as we cannot pay for unused tickets.**

If however, you are in receipt of Free School Meals (not Universal free school meals received by Rec, Yr1 and 2) and have not yet informed us, please contact the school office as you might be eligible for a part remission of charges. Under the terms of the Education Reform Act (1988) we can only ask for voluntary contributions towards educational journeys (transport/insurance/entry fees) Of course if you feel you are able to make any contribution towards the cost it would be greatly appreciated.

As always, to enable us to run the trip we need to receive all contributions from parents who are eligible to pay. If you are not in receipt of the above and are unable to make the contribution please do not hesitate to contact me.
