Homework

Reading: As always, reading is an essential part of your child's education and works as a partnership between school and home. The children have quality reading time regularly where they read to an adult and receive feedback, as well as reading lessons and reading activities. Please encourage your child to read every night, or as much as possible. Questioning them on the book they are reading is an effective way to help develop their reading skills. There is a bookshelf placed in your child's reading record where they should write the book title on once a book has been completed. When 3 books have been written on to the sheet, they will then receive a raffle ticket and be placed in to the reading prize draw.

Maths and English: Each week children will be sent home with a Maths and English book. Homework books will be sent home on a **Thursday** and should be returned no later than **Monday**. We encourage children to look at their homework on a Thursday so any questions can be asked Friday to enable them to complete it on time. The tasks set will **consolidate** learning in the classroom. If your child struggles with any of the activities, please write a note so that we can go through this with them in class.

Spellings: A weekly home learning spelling task will be sent home each week on **Thursday**. Children will be familiar with the content of this, having learnt the spelling rule 3 times in class that week before the task comes home. There will be **no weekly spelling test**.

P.E

Children will be able to attend school in full PE Uniform on their timetabled PE day - Tuesday.

As part of the National Curriculum, your child will have swimming lessons in year 5. The lessons will take place at Sedburgh Pool every Wednesday morning in term time and will start on 13th September, 2023. Pupils are required to wear a swimming costume/trunks or fully lined swimming shorts (not Bermuda-type shorts) and will need goggles and a towel. Swimming hats are required for children with longer hair.

PE Uniform is plain white t-shirt, plain black shorts or plain black jogging bottoms, plain black sweat top and plain black trainers. Pumps/plimsolls are not required. Plain black trainers are allowed to be worn instead of school shoes, however if you prefer to send your child to school in school shoes, then they must also have plain black trainers with them for impromptu active sessions.

What to bring/What not to bring

Please bring school bags, reading books and reading records every day. Children should also bring a named water bottle in daily. Children may also bring a healthy snack to school for playtime. Alternatively, you can contact the office to order a daily snack and/or milk.

Every alternate Friday (Please see the Foxhill Newsletter for further details) children may bring in achievement certificates, badges or trophies rewarded at home, to show in our Celebration Assembly.

Please do not bring/wear jewellery (except studs), nail varnish, mobile phones, large hair pieces or toys.

Please double check your child's name is in **all** uniform, coat, P.E Uniform and school bag.
