# KS2 Acceptable User Policy (AUP) for ICT Equipment and the Internet

These rules will help to keep you and your classmates safe when using ICT.

## I will follow these rules to keep me safe

#### SCHOOL'S COMPUTING EQUIPMENT

- I will take care of school-owned ICT equipment.
- I will not eat or drink while using school-owned ICT equipment.
- I will only use the school's computers for my school work or homework.
- I will keep my password secret and only log on as myself.
- I will not try to install any software or change any settings on the computers and devices in school.
- I will return school loaned equipment when I have finished using it.

## SOCIAL MEDIA

- I know that some websites and social networks have age restrictions and I should not use them unless I am old enough.
- I will not say nasty or hurtful things about any member of staff or pupil online.
- If I see any hurtful comments about staff or pupils online, I will take a screenshot and report it to my Teacher / Headteacher.

## DIGITIAL CONTENT

- I will only use school-owned equipment to create pictures, video and sound.
- Pictures, video and sound will not be taken without asking permission first.
- I will not publish anything online at School, without asking my Teacher's permission first.

## REMOTE LEARNING

• I will complete work set on-line as best as I can.

- I will seek help if I need it.
- I will inform School if I am not able to complete online learning.

**EMAIL** (This year, KS2 children will have access to a MONITORED email address, ring fenced within School)

- I will take care opening any attachments sent by email. I will not open or download an attachment unless I trust the person who sent it.
- When sending email, I will make sure they are polite and sensible.

## MOBILE PHONES and SMART WATCHES

- I will not bring my phone or mobile device to school.
- I will not bring a smart watch into School.
- I will not take or share inappropriate images of others.
- I will not send hurtful or inappropriate text messages to others.

## E-SAFETY / ANTI CYBER-BULLYING

- I will turn off the monitor (screen) if I see something that I feel uncomfortable with or upsets me; then I will tell my teacher straight away.
- I will not try to access any websites that the school has blocked access to, or try to look for, or save anything, that is unpleasant.
- I will never arrange to meet anyone I have only met online.
- I will not give away my personal details (full name, age, birthday, school, address etc.) or the personal details of other users.
- I know that my use of ICT can be checked and that my parent/carer will be contacted if a member of school staff is concerned for my safety.
